


Speakers

Greg Boyd, senior pastor of Woodland Hills Church in St. Paul, MN, is a gifted speaker whose passionate relationship with God is evident in all that he teaches. Greg is a favorite teacher at The Master's Institute, the seminary birthed out of Lutheran Renewal. Greg is also a prolific writer whose books include: *Letters From a Sceptic*, *Satan and the Problem of Evil*, and *Bad Things Happen, and It's Not God's Plan*.




Larry Christenson, former Director of Lutheran Renewal, is a best-selling author and popular speaker. He has written many articles and books, including the recently published *Ride the River*, in which he draws parallels between the Lewis and Clark expedition and the Christian's life of following the Lord. Larry is a teacher whose insights are both practical and inspirational.

Rick Joyner, along with his wife Julie, founded MorningStar Publications and Ministries in 1985. Rick is the senior pastor of the MorningStar Fellowship that now holds services in both Charlotte and Wilkesboro, NC. He oversees many ministries, all of which are part of MorningStar's commitment to equip future leaders and work in relationship with current leaders. Rick is a well-known author of more than 30 books. In addition, he is a popular conference speaker whose messages are born out of his prophetic gifting.



R.T. Kendall, born and raised in Kentucky, is a hugely popular writer and one of the best-known leaders and teachers in the United Kingdom. R.T. was the pastor of Westminster Chapel in London for 25 years and he has recently moved to Florida. He is well-known internationally as a speaker, and is the author of over 30 books, including: *God Meant It for Good*, *The Anointing*, and *Total Forgiveness*. He has learned firsthand the challenge and the power of walking in total forgiveness.

Charles Simpson is an internationally-known author, Bible teacher, motivational speaker, and pastor, who has been in ministry since 1955. His humor and story-telling often carry a deeper message that is prophetic in its timeliness and timelessness. He became a pioneer and leader in the Charismatic Renewal, traveling around the world and teaching thousands of people. In 1973, Charles and a team of pastors founded Covenant Church of Mobile, Alabama. This new church also had a strong emphasis on praise and worship. In 1985, Covenant Church and New Wine gave birth to Integrity Music, which is now the largest praise and worship company in the world.



Jenny has a vision to release the love of God into the hearts of children through times of worship, teaching, personal prayer ministry, and the arts.

Cost: \$15 per day per child, or \$45 per day (maximum family rate). Includes lunch, snacks, and materials. **Registration forms must be received in our office before July 23 for this rate.** After July 23: \$20 per day per child, or \$60 per day (maximum family rate). On-site and late registrations are dependent on room availability.
